Position Overview:

HopeStone is seeking twelve young adult missionaries to form **PROJECT XII**, a 10-month missionary discipleship and leadership formation experience rooted in Catholic faith, relational ministry, and evangelization. Under the direction of the HopeStone leadership team, disciples will serve in a variety of ministry settings including retreats, camps, parish events, school programs, and conferences. This role is both **practical ministry and intentional formation**, designed to develop missionary disciples who lead with integrity, humility, and courage.

PROJECT XII is not only a position of service, but a year of transformation—personally, spiritually, and missionally. Missionaries are called to live and serve in a way that reflects Christ through presence, relationship, and authentic witness.

Responsibilities:

- Actively engage with youth and community members through relational ministry.
- Facilitate games, activities, and events to foster faith and fellowship.
- Lead small group and large group discussions on faith-related topics.
- Present provided content in an engaging and authentic manner.
- Assist in event setup, transitions, and takedown of equipment.
- Participate in team meetings and contribute to program development.

General Requirements:

- Able to minister to youth (grades 5-12) and engage with various age groups.
- Availability for weekdays and select Saturdays. Must commit to 2-4 days per week.
- A mature and active spiritual life in full communion with the Catholic Church.
- Strong understanding of Church doctrine and the ability to effectively communicate it.
- Ability to work independently while maintaining a collaborative spirit.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills.
- Must have a valid driver's license and access to reliable transportation or be willing to use public transit.
- Must provide a criminal background check and vulnerable sector check.
- Experience in youth ministry, Sacramental preparation, or music ministry is an asset.
